

## **SOLAR ECLIPSE PLANNING**

If you are planning on hosting an event or group of people at your property during the upcoming Solar Eclipse, the Fremont County Commissioners would like you to consider having a plan in place to ensure everyone's safety, health and welfare.

Please consider the following issues **as far in advance** of the event as possible.

Be aware, locating portable toilet facilities may be difficult without an early plan. The septic system on your property is not designed for a large number of people using it and could be easily overwhelmed by your visitors. Outhouses are not legal in Fremont County due to soil and groundwater contamination so dealing with sewage may be a major concern. For a list of contractors with portable toilets, please contact the **Fremont County Planning Department at 307-332-1077**.

### **For event planning purposes, please consider the following:**

#### **1. Police and Emergency Services.**

- A. Please contact **Fremont County Sheriff's Office 307-332-5611 or 307-857-3610** to inform them of your plans.
- B. Please contact **Guardian EMS at 307-206-1083** to inform them of your plans. If you will have First Responders of EMS personnel at your event, let Guardian know.

#### **2. Is there adequate access to your property for your intended visitors?**

- A. If access is via a County Road, have you contacted **Fremont County Transportation Department 307-332-1038** to get necessary approvals for access?
- B. If access is via a State Highway, have you contacted **WYDOT 307-332-4151** to get necessary approvals for access?
- C. Do you have a valid address for the property so that emergency crews can find you? If not, please contact **Fremont County Planning at 307-332-1077** to obtain an address.

#### **3. Do you live on a Private Road?**

- A. Have you contacted your neighbors to inform them of your plan?
- B. With the additional traffic volumes, who will handle the road maintenance?

C. Do you have a contract for road maintenance?

**4. What is the status of water and sewer at your property?**

A. How will Potable Water Services be handled?

I. Will it be provided by a well(s)?

i. Is there an adequate supply? The **State Engineers Office at 307-856-0747** may be able to help.

II. Will a local community be providing the water?

i. Has the local community been contacted to insure they can supply the necessary amount of water?

III. If water will be hauled in, have you contracted with a hauler? Signing up with a contractor early in the process is recommended.

B. How will Sewage be handled?

I. If an additional septic system will be required, you **must** work with **Fremont County Planning 307-332-1077** to receive a permit.

II. If you will use temporary portable toilets, have you contracted for them? **There are a limited number available in Fremont County so early contracting is suggested.**

III. If it will be hauled, has the local community been contacted to insure their sewer plant can handle the additional septic?

**5. How will Solid Waste services be handled for your event?**

A. Have you contacted a Waste Hauler? **Early notice will insure the availability of waste containers.** Please contact **Wyoming Waste Systems 307-856-5354, Hopper Metals 307-463-4511 or Lander Valley Sanitation 307-330-3181.**
