WHEREAS, on the 10th day of May, 2017, the budget officer filed with BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that after deducting all available cash the Board of Trustees of Fremont County School District #14 a tentative and estimated revenues the following amounts must be raised through budget and budget message for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, and general taxation, and that such levies as are required to provide such amounts are hereby authorized as of and for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018.

WHEREAS, a summary of such budget was entered into the Board minutes, and notice of a public hearing on such budget was together with said summary was published in the Riverton Ranger, a newspaper having general circulation in the county in which the district is located on the 28th day of June, 2017, or notice was posted in three conspicuous places in the District;

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held concerning such budget on Thursday July 6th 2017 at 5:30 p.m., at which time all interested parties will be given an opportunity to be heard.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Fremont County School District #14 that such budget, as revised, if adopted and, subject to future amendment, is in effect for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following appropriations are made as of and for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, and that those respective expenditures applicable to each department and fund shall be limited to the amounts hereby appropriated, subject to future amendment.
